

## SAFETY

- 1) Always wear slip resistant shoes when operating a floor machine on wet surfaces.
- 2) Always check electrical cords for breaks and plugs for ground prongs.
- 3) Always read the dilution ratio on the chemicals and mix only according to manufacturers directions.

## SCRUB AND RECOAT



**Choose quality equipment for the most effective cleaning.**

### Purpose:

To remove build-up of water resistant soil, black heel marks, or heavy dirt deposits from the floor.

### Supplies and Equipment

2 buckets and wringer

Floor hazard signs

2 wet mops with handles

Neutral all purpose cleaner

24 inch dry dust mop

Floor machine

Blue or green floor pad to fit machine

Wet/dry vac

### Procedure:

A) Place floor hazard signs in easy-to-see locations at entrances to area where floor is to be scrubbed.

B) Dry dust mop or vacuum the floor.

C) Move furniture. Work around heavy furniture. Tilt file cabinets and put on blocks.

D) Fill bucket #1 with neutral solution and room temperature water.

Fill bucket #2 with room temperature clear water. (for rinsing)

E) Attach green or blue pad to the drive pad of the floor machine. Move equipment to the area to be cleaned and set up.

F) Dip mop into cleaning solution and wring out slightly. Apply solution to an area approximately 7'X7'. Allow to stand 2 to 3 minutes.



**Invest in a quality low speed buffer and it will last for years.**

G) Agitate using the floor machine and the blue or green pad.

H) Remove the solution using the wet/dry vac.

I) Rinse using the water in bucket #2 and a clean mop.

J) Allow to air dry.

K) Repeat procedure until the entire area is complete.

L) You may add 1 to 2 coats of floor finish at this point. If the area has an excellent base of finish already, you may simply buff using a 1500 rpm floor machine.

### Clean-up:

A) Rinse floor pads and mops and hang to dry.

B) Rinse mop buckets and allow to air dry.

C) Wipe floor machine and cord. Store the drive pad on the handle of the machine.

D) Brush dust mop out and hang to store.
